Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. That the Commissioner of Buildings, the Executive Director of Construction and Permits, the Commissioner of Transportation, the Commissioner of Streets and Sanitation, the Commissioner of Environment, the Commissioner of Fire, the Director of Business Affairs & Licensing, the Director of Revenue and the Commissioner of Water Management, are hereby directed to issue all necessary permits, all on-site water/sewer inspection fees and all water/sewer plan review fees, free of charge, notwithstanding other ordinances of the City of Chicago to the contrary, to DEPAUL UNIVERSITY a not-for-profit Illinois corporation, related to the construction and maintenance of building(s) and other temporary structures at said location(s):

300 South Wabash Avenue, Chicago, Illinois 60604
23 East Jackson Boulevard, Chicago, Illinois 60604

333 South State Street Chicago, Illinois 60604
247 South State Street Chicago, Illinois 60604
243 South Wabash Avenue, Chicago, Illinois 60604
50 East Jackson Boulevard, Chicago, Illinois 60604

Said building(s) and all appurtenances thereto shall be used exclusively for charitable purposes and shall not be leased or otherwise used with a view to profit, and the work thereon shall be done in accordance with the plans submitted and all of the appropriate provisions of the Municipal Code of the City of Chicago and departmental requirements of various departments of the City of Chicago, and said building(s) and all appurtenances thereto shall be constructed and maintained so that they shall comply in all respects with the requirements of the appropriate provisions of the Municipal Code of the City of Chicago for the issuance of all necessary permits and licenses.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> <u>DEPAUL UNIVERSITY</u>, a not-for-profit Illinois Corporation, engaged in medical, educational and related activities, shall be exempt from the payment of City license fees and shall be entitled to the cancellation of warrants for collection of inspection fees.

SECTION 3. DEPAUL UNIVERSITY, shall be entitled to a refund of City fees which it has paid and from which it is exempt pursuant to Sections 1 and 2 of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be in force for the period of March 16, 2011 through March 15, 2013.

Consequently, sales of any kind to this organization are exempt from the Retailers' Occupation Tax, the Service Occupation Tax (both state and local), the Use Tax, and the Service Service Use Tax in Illinois.

We have Issued your organization the following tax exemption identification number: E9990-9022-07. To claim the exemption, you must provide this number to your suppliers when purchasing tangible personal property for organizational use. This exemption may not be used by individual members of the organization to make purchases for their individual use.

This exemption will expire on February 1, 2015, unless you apply to the Illinois Department of Revenue for renewal at least three months prior to the expiration date.
