BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning

District symbols as shown on Map No. 7-J
in the area bounded by:

West Belmont Avenue, a line 106.69 feet west of and parallel to North Central Park

Avenue; the alley next south of and parallel to West Belmont Avenue; and a line 131.69

feet west of and parallel to North Central Park Avenue.


