BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO

SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by changing all of the RS-3 Residential Multi-Unit District symbols and indications as shown on Map No. 1-I in an area bound by:

The alley next north of and parallel to West Erie Street; a line 285.70 feet west of and parallel to North Western Avenue; West Erie Street; and a line 333.70 feet west of and parallel to North Western Avenue.

To those of an RM-4.5 Residential Single-Unit (Detached House) District.

SECTION 2. This ordinance takes effect after its passage and due publication.


