Amendment of Municipal Code Section 9-52-010 regarding bicyclists rights on city roadways Committee on Transportation and Public Way

ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Section 9-52-010 of the Municipal Code of the City of Chicago is hereby amended by deleting the language stricken, and by inserting the language underscored, as follows:

9-52-010 Rights and duties.

(a) Every bicyclist upon a roadway shall be granted all of the rights and shall be subject to all of the duties applicable to the driver of a vehicle by the laws of this state declaring rules of the road applicable to vehicles or by the traffic ordinances of this <u>City</u> applicable to the driver of a vehicle and bicyclists shall be permitted and intended users of all roadways in the City, except as otherwise explicitly provided in this Code or by clear. conspicuous signage posted on the public way pursuant to an ordinance adopted by City Council, or as to those provisions of laws and ordinances which by their nature can have no application.

(b) The regulations in the traffic code applicable to bicycles shall apply whenever a bicycle is operated upon any roadway or public sidewalk or upon any public path set aside for the use of bicycles, subject to those exceptions stated herein.

(c) Whenever authorized signs are erected indicating that no right or left turn or turn in the opposite direction is permitted, no bicyclist shall disobey the direction of any such sign unless he dismounts from the bicycle to make the turn, in which event he shall then obey the regulations applicable to pedestrians.

(Omitted text is unaffected by this ordinance)

SECTION 2. No later than July 31, 2023, the Comptroller shall, in consultation with the Commissioner of Transportation and the Corporation Counsel, publish a form for members of the public to submit claims for damage to bicycles and for medical care resulting from an injury related to insufficient road design or maintenance where the City would be liable for such damages. Such from shall be substantially similar to the form to submit claims for damage to motor vehicles. The Comptroller and Corporation Counsel shall establish rules for the processing and review of such claims to expedite recovery for valid claims against the City in the same manner as claims for damage to motor vehicles.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage.
