BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. The Chicago Zoning Ordinance is amended by changing all of the B3-1, Community Shopping District and indications as shown on Map No. 20-G in the area bound by:

West 86th Place; South Summit and South Vincennes Avenues; West 87th Street; and, the alley next east of and parallel to South Sangamon Street

to those of a C1-1, Neighborhood Commercial District.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be effective after its passage and publication.

In accordance with the requirements of Section 17-13-0107 of the Municipal Code of the City of Chicago, please be informed that on or about April 19, 2023, the undersigned will file an application for a change in zoning from the B3-1, Community Shopping District to a C1-1, Neighborhood Commercial District on behalf of the SSNS Construction Inc. (the "Applicant") for the property commonly known as 842-852 West 87th Street, 8674-8698 South Vincennes Avenue and 835-853 West 86th Place (the "Property").

The Applicant proposes to develop the site with a gas station, tunnel car wash and commercial retail space. The gas station island will include four fuel pump stations, with a canopy to service 8 cars. The tunnel car wash will be 1,560 SF and approximately 30 feet tall.
