#### **ORDINANCE**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by changing all of the RT-4-Residential Two Flats Townhouse and Multi-Unit-District and CI-2 Neighborhood Commercial District symbols and indications as shown on Map No. 4-1 in the area bounded by

Adjine 121 feet north of and parallel to West Cermak Road as measured along the Northeast intersection of South St. Louis Avenue and West Cermak Road; the alley next east of and parallel to South St. Louis Avenue; West Cermak Road; and South St. Louis Avenue.

to those of a C2-2 Motor Vehicle -Related Commercial District.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and due publication.


