BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by changing all of the B3-1 Community Shopping District symbols and indications as shown on Map No. 12-M in the area bounded by

The public alley next northwest of and parallel to South Archer Avenue; South Archer Avenue; a line 21.85 feet east of and almost parallel to South Austin Avenue (as measured along the southeast boundary line of the public alley next northwest of and parallel to South Archer Avenue),

to those of an B2-2 Neighborhood Mixed-Use District.

SECTION 2. This ordinance takes effect after its passage and approval.

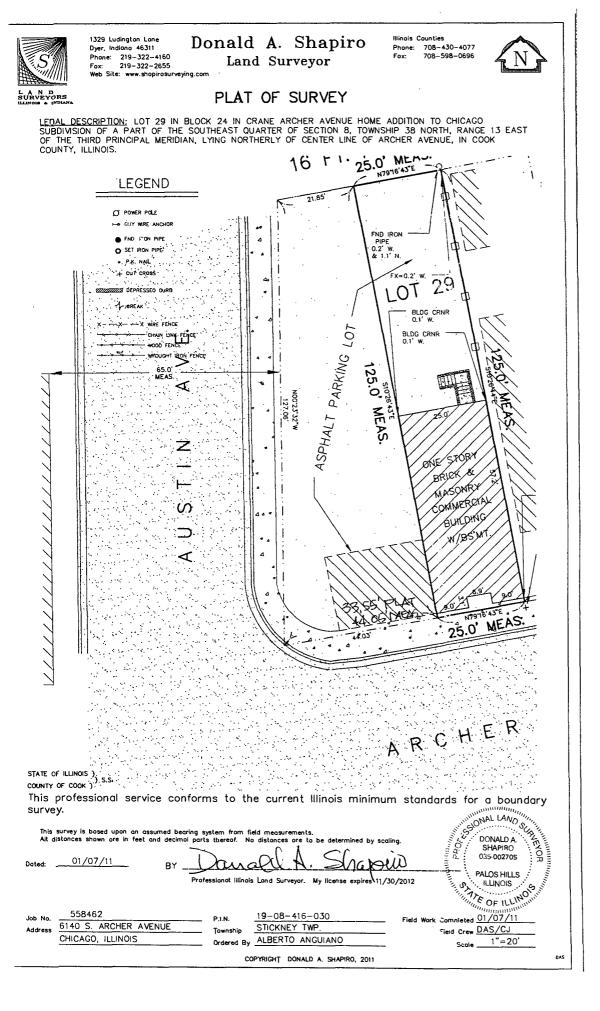
