

*Program Summary*

In the 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter of 2010:

- 8 contracts expired
- 10 new TIFWorks contracts were issued
- 29 contracts are active
- 458 incumbent workers were trained
- 39 individuals were trained and hired into new positions of employment

Of the 29 active projects:

- 729 incumbent workers have been trained to date
- 66 individuals have been trained and hired into new positions of employment to date
