**ORDINANCE**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Council finds that the area described in Sections 2 and 3 of this ordinance is adversely affected by the over-concentration of businesses licensed to sell alcoholic liquor within and near the area.

**SECTION 2.** Section 4-60-022 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by inserting the underscored language as a new subsection 4-60-022 (30.51), as follows:

4-60-22        Restrictions on additional licenses.

Subject to the provisions of subsection 4-60-021(c), no additional license shall be issued for the sale of alcoholic liquor, for consumption on the premises within the following areas:

(30.51)        On Milwaukee Avenue, from Hamlin Avenue to Central Park Avenue (southwest side only)

**SECTION 3.** Section 4-60-023 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by inserting the underscored language as a new subsection 4-60-023 (30.60), as follows:

4-60-23        Restrictions on additional package goods licenses.


Subject to the provisions of subsection 4-60-021c, no additional package goods license shall be issued for any premises located within the following areas:

30.60        On Milwaukee Avenue, from Hamlin Avenue to Central Park Avenue (southwest side only)

**SECTION 4.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
