**WHEREAS**, Lawrence Eagleburger has been called to eternal life by the wisdom of God at the age of eighty; and

**WHEREAS**, The Chicago City Council has been informed of his passing by Alderman Edward M. Burke; and

**WHEREAS**, Lawrence Eagleburger was the loving and devoted husband of Marlene Ann, nee Heinemann; and

**WHEREAS**, Lawrence Eagleburger was the much-adored father of three sons to whom he imparted many of the fine and noble qualities which he possessed in abundance; and

**WHEREAS**, A distinguished diplomat and public servant, Lawrence Eagleburger served as the 62<sup>nd</sup> United States Secretary of State under President George H.W. Bush; and

**WHEREAS**, Prior to assuming this role, Lawrence Eagleburger served as deputy to former Secretary of State James Baker, undertaking and handling complex foreign policy issues; and

**WHEREAS**, Lawrence Eagleburger held several high-ranking positions during his twenty-seven years with the foreign service, including U.S. Ambassador to Yugoslavia under President Jimmy Carter; and

**WHEREAS**, Lawrence Eagleburger was the first foreign service officer in American history to assume the role of Secretary of State; and



**WHEREAS**, To his beloved family, Lawrence Eagleburger imparts a legacy of faithfulness, service and dignity; now, therefore
