
**S U B S T I T U T E O R D I N A N C E****BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Council finds that the areas described in Section 2 of this ordinance are adversely affected by the over-concentration of businesses licensed to sell alcoholic liquor within and near the areas.

**SECTION 2.** Section 4-60-023 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by replacing subsection 4-60-023 (38.39), which was previously deleted as shown in the Journal of Proceedings of June 30, 2010 at pages 95365 through 95366, with the following underscored text:

4-60-023 (38.39)      On the north side of Belmont Avenue, from Linder Avenue to Major Avenue.

**SECTION 3.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
