BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning
Ordinance is hereby amended by changing all of the RS3 Residential Single—Unit
(Detached House) District symbols as shown on Map No. 5 - I
in the area bounded by:

West Belden Avenue; a line 644.92 feet East of and parallel to North Sacramento Avenue; a public alley next South of and parallel to West Belden Avenue; a line 620.92 feet East of and parallel to North Sacramento Avenue.

To those of an RT4, Residential Two-Flat, Townhouse and Multi-Unit District

SECTION 2. This Ordinance takes effect after its passage and approval.

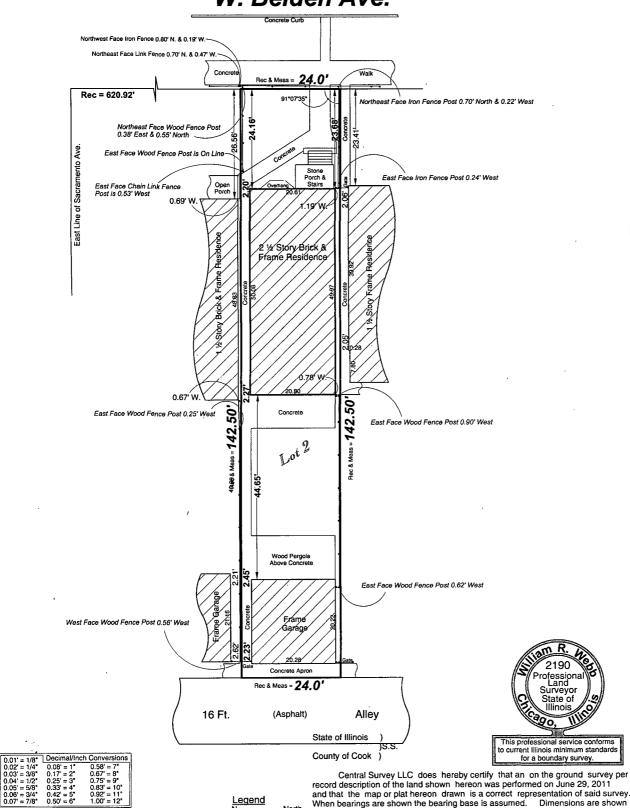
