#### ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the City of Chicago (the "City") is a home rule unit of government under Section 6(a), Article VII of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the Chicago Youth Shooting Review (the "CYSR") is an initiative of Chapin Hall Center for Children (also known as Chapin Hall at the University of Chicago), an Illinois not-for-profit corporation ("Chapin Hall"), to share and analyze information regarding Chicago school-age shootings across and among governmental agencies and entities; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to participate in the CYSR; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. The above recitals are expressly incorporated in and made a part of this ordinance as though fully set forth herein.

SECTION 2. The Mayor of the City or his designee (in either case, the "Authorized Officer") is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute one or more intergovernmental agreements for the CYSR (the "IGAs") with other governmental entities, including but not limited to the Board of Education of the City of Chicago, the Chicago Housing Authority, the County of Cook, the State of Illinois and the United States of America, and to perform any and all acts as shall be necessary or advisable in connection with the City's performance under the IGAs. The IGAs shall contain such terms as the Authorized Officer deems necessary (including regarding indemnification).

SECTION 3. The Authorized Officer is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute a participation agreement for the CYSR (the "Participation Agreement," and, with the IGAs, the "Agreements") with Chapin Hall, and to perform any and all acts as shall be necessary or advisable in connection with the City's performance under the Participation Agreement. The Participation Agreement shall contain such terms as the Authorized Officer deems necessary (including regarding indemnification). One or more other governmental entities may also be a party to the Participation Agreement. The City is authorized to accept Chapin Hall's performance under the Participation Agreement as a grant-in-kind of services.

SECTION 4. The Authorized Officer is hereby authorized to share City information regarding Chicago school-age shootings with other governmental entities and Chapin Hall as the Authorized Officer deems necessary and as may be required by the Agreements, subject to applicable law.

SECTION 5. To the extent that any ordinance, resolution, rule, order or provision of the Municipal Code of Chicago, or part thereof, is in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, the provisions of this ordinance shall control. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the other provisions of this ordinance.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall be effective as of the date of its passage and approval.
