Vacation of public alley(s) in area bounded W Lake St, N Pulaski Rd, N Harding Ave and W Kinzie St Committee on Transportation and Public Way

INTERGOVERNMENTAL ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the City of Chicago ("City") is a home rule unit of local government pursuant to Article VII, Section 6 (a) of the 1970 constitution of the State of Illinois and, as such; may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, the properties at 343-379 N. Pulaski Rd., 344-384 N. Harding Ave., are owned by the City of Chicago, a Municipal Corporation; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Housing and Economic Development proposes to assemble properties including the portion of the alleys to be vacated and ultimately convey them to the Chicago Transit Authority; and

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Chicago, after due investigation and consideration, has determined that the nature and extent of public use and the public interest to be subserved is such as to warrant the vacation of part of the public alleys described in the following ordinance; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1.

Vacation:

That part of the North-South 16 foot alley West of and adjoining Lots 1 through 16 (except the South 16 feet thereof) in E.A. Cummings' Lake Street Addition to Chicago, recorded February 28, 1893 as Document Number 1823098; and that part of the North-South 16 foot alley lying East of and adjoining Lots 1 through 15 in the subdivision of part of the West 10 acres lying North of Lake Street, recorded February 4, 1874 as Document Number 145504, lying North of the North line of the South 16 feet of Lot 16 extended Westerly in said E.A. Cummings' Lake Street Addition to Chicago, and that part of the East-West alley lying North of Lot 1 in said Subdivision of the West 10 acres, all in Section 11, Township 39 North, Range 13 East of the Third Principal Meridian, in Cook County, Illinois as shaded and indicated by the words "HEREBY VACATED" on the drawing hereto attached,

and

Opening:

The South 16 feet of Lot 16 in E.A. Cummings' Lake Street Addition to Chicago, recorded February 28, 1893 as Document Number 1823098, in Section 11, Township 39 North, Range 13 East of the Third Principal Meridian, in Cook County, Illinois as shaded and indicated by the words "HEREBY OPENED" on the drawing hereto attached.

Both drawings for greater clarity are hereby made a part of this ordinance, be and the same are hereby vacated and opened, inasmuch as the vacation area is no longer required for public use and the public interest will be subserved by such vacation and opening.

SECTION 2. The City of Chicago hereby reserves for the benefit of Commonwealth Edison, their successors or assigns, an easement to operate, maintain, construct, replace, and renew overhead poles, wires, and associated equipment and underground conduit, cables, and associated equipment for the transmission and distribution of electrical energy, over, and along that portion of the alleys as herein vacated with the right of ingress and egress.

SECTION 3. The vacation herein provided for is made upon the express condition that within one hundred eighty (180) days after the passage of this ordinance, the applicant shall file or cause to be filed for record in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds of Cook County, Illinois a certified copy of this ordinance, together with an attached drawing approved by authorized staff of Chicago Department of Transportation/Maps and Plats.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication. The vacation and opening shall take effect and be in force from and after its recording.



Pursuant to a request from Ms. Mary Bonome, we are transmitting herewith for your review and approval as to form and legality an original and three (3) copies of a proposed vacation of the northernmost 16' E-W alley and a portion of the 16' N-S alley; also a 16' E-W opening in the block bounded by W. Lake St., N. Pulaski Rd., N. Harding Ave. & W. Kinzie St. This property is located in the 27th Ward.

The Department of Housing & Economic Development is the owner of record to the properties adjoining the public street & alley to be vacated.
