## Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> That the Commissioner of Buildings, the Executive Director of Construction and Permits, the Commissioner of Transportation, the Commissioner of Streets and Sanitation, the Commissioner of Environment, the Commissioner of Fire, the Director of Business Affairs & Licensing, the Director of Revenue and the Commissioner of Water Management, are hereby directed to issue all necessary permits, all on-site water/sewer inspection fees and all water/sewer plan review fees, free of charge, notwithstanding other ordinances of the City of Chicago to the contrary, to <u>Legal Assistance Foundation of Metropolitan Chicago</u>, a not-for-profit Illinois corporation, related to the construction and maintenance of building(s) at said location(s):

## 120 South LaSalle Street, 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> Floors, Chicago, Illinois

Said building(s) and all appurtenances thereto shall be used exclusively for charitable purposes and shall not be leased or otherwise used with a view to profit, and the work thereon shall be done in accordance with the plans submitted and all of the appropriate provisions of the Municipal Code of the City of Chicago and departmental requirements of various departments of the City of Chicago, and said building(s) and all appurtenances thereto shall be constructed and maintained so that they shall comply in all respects with the requirements of the appropriate provisions of the Municipal Code of the City of Chicago for the issuance of all necessary permits and licenses.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> <u>Legal Assistance Foundation of Metropolitan Chicago</u>, a notfor-profit Illinois Corporation, engaged in medical, educational and related activities, shall be exempt from the payment of City license fees and shall be entitled to the cancellation of warrants for collection of inspection fees.

**SECTION 3.** Legal Assistance Foundation of Metropolitan Chicago shall be entitled to a refund of City fees which it has paid and from which it is exempt pursuant to Sections 1 and 2 of this ordinance.

**SECTION 4.** This ordinance shall be in force for the period of June 1, 2011 through May 31, 2013.

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


