### AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING HUMANITARIAN AID TO KANDAHAR, AFGHANISTAN

Whereas, from time to time, emergency vehicles and equipment used by the City of Chicago become outdated and obsolete and are replaced, and

Whereas, such material may nonetheless have useful service life left in it and could be of great use to another entity, and

Whereas, the City of Chicago, Department of Fleet Management, from time to time, has in its possession fire trucks and equipment that, while no longer of use to the City, could be of substantial use elsewhere; and

Whereas, KANDAHAR, Afghanistan is in need of humanitarian aid,

### NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

Section 1 The Commissioner of Fleet Management is hereby authorized to donate one obsolete Fire Department Ambulance no longer useful to the City of Chicago; as such ambulance may become available, to the City of Kandahar, Afghanistan, free and clear of any liens or encumbrances. The City shall convey said Fire Department ambulance in "as is" condition without any warranties either expresses or implied and expressly excludes any warranty of merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose.

Section 2. The Commissioner of Fleet Management is hereby authorized to enter into and execute such other documents, as may be necessary and proper to implement this donation.

Section 3 This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication
