840 NORTH LAKE SHORE DRIVE CONDOMINIUM ASSOCIATION  
Acct. No. 279969 - 2  
Permit No. 1098377

*Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:*

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to 840 NORTH LAKE SHORE DRIVE CONDOMINIUM ASSOCIATION, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use, as now constructed, seven (7) Pile Caps(s) under the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 840 N. Lake Shore Dr..

Said Pile Caps(s) at E. Pearson measure(s):

One (1) at seventy-nine (79) feet in length, and point five (.5) feet in width for a total of thirty-nine point five (39.5) square feet.

One (1) at thirty-three (33) feet in length, and three (3) feet in width for a total of ninety-nine (99) square feet.

One (1) at five (5) feet in length, and point five (.5) feet in width for a total of two point five (2.5) square feet.

One (1) at three (3) feet in length, and one point seven five (1.75) foot in width for a total of five point two five (5.25) square feet.

Said Pile Caps(s) at E. Pearson & N. Lake Shore Dr measure(s):

One (1) at seven (7) feet in length, and one point five (1.5) foot in width for a total of ten point five (10.5) square feet.

Said Pile Caps(s) at N. Lake Shore Dr measure(s):

One (1) at ten (10) feet in length, and one point five (1.5) foot in width for a total of fifteen (15) square feet

Said Pile Caps(s) at N. Lake shore Dr measure(s):

One (1) at twenty-six (26) feet in length, and one point five (1.5) foot in width for a total of thirty-nine (39) square feet.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Transportation (Office of Underground Coordination).

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1098377 herein granted the sum of four hundred (\$400.00) per annum in advance.

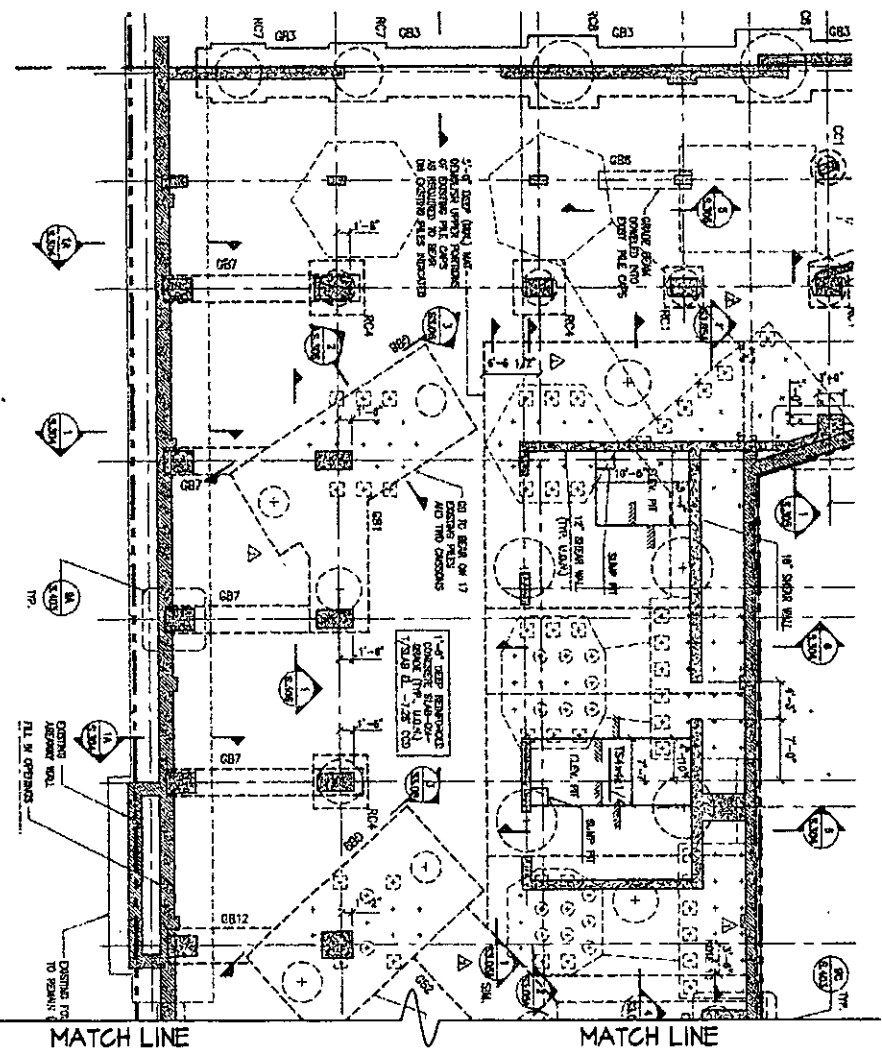
A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

Authority herein given and granted for a period of five (5) years from and after Date of Passage.
