ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1.

Section 17-3-0503-D of Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by deleting the stricken language and inserting the underscored language as follows:

[The other pedestrian streets and pedestrian retail streets in these subsections are unaffected by the changes and are not included for editorial convenience,]
