RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Magdalena H. Pallasch has been called to eternal life by the wisdom of God at the age of 103; and

WHEREAS, The Chicago City Council has been informed of her passing by Alderman Edward M. Burke; and

WHEREAS, Magdalena H. Pallasch was a Chicago portrait painter and the loving wife of the late Bernhard M.; and

WHEREAS, Magdalena H. Pallasch was the much-adored mother of B. Michael and Diana and the grandmother of four; and

WHEREAS, The daughter of Austrian immigrants, Magdalena H. Pallasch was born on Chicago's North Side and studied privately with renowned American painter Joseph Allworthy at his Scott Street studio; and

WHEREAS, Magdalena H. Pallasch graduated from Lake View High School and the American Academy of Fine Arts in Chicago; and

WHEREAS, Magdalena H. Pallasch began her early career as an illustrator and during the 1933 Century of Progress International Exposition exhibited works chronicling women's fashions; and

WHEREAS, While raising her family in the Lake View neighborhood, Magdalena H. Pallasch earned a reputation as an accomplished portrait painter while her husband ran the North Shore Delivery Company; and

WHEREAS, The presidents of universities, medical associations and prestigious bodies sat for paintings by Magdalena H. Pallasch; and

WHEREAS, Magdalena H. Pallasch painted the official portrait of Francis Cardinal George which hangs in the Cardinal's residence on State Parkway and the painting of John Cardinal Cody found at the Chancellery Office of the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Chicago; and

WHEREAS, Magdalena H. Pallasch was a faithful member of St. Mary of the Lake Parish on the North Side of Chicago and throughout her life was known for her positive attitude and kindness toward others; and

WHEREAS, Magdalena H. Pallasch will be dearly missed and fondly remembered by her many relatives, friends and admirers; and

WHEREAS, To her beloved family, Magdalena H. Pallasch imparts a legacy of faithfulness, service and dignity; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, That we, the Mayor and the members of the Chicago City Council, assembled this ninth day of November, 2011, do hereby commemorate Magdalena H. Pallasch for her grace-filled life and do hereby express our condolences to her family; and
