ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the City of Chicago (the "City"), a home rule unit of government under Section 6(a), Article VII of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois, has heretofore found and does hereby find that there exists within the City a serious shortage of decent, safe and sanitary rental housing available to persons of low and moderate income, and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that the continuance of a shortage of affordable rental housing is harmful to the health, prosperity, economic stability and general welfare of the City, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to an ordinance of the City Council of the City of Chicago ("City Council") enacted on March 11, 1987, the predecessor department to the City's Department of Housing and Economic Development ("HED") made a loan ("1414 Loan") in the original principal amount of \$156,188.00 to Latin United Community Housing Association, an Illinois not-for-profit corporation ("LUCHA"), the proceeds of which were used to rehabilitate an apartment building located at 1414 North Washtenaw Avenue, Chicago, Illinois (the "1414 Property"); and

WHEREAS, the 1414 Loan was secured by, among other things, a mortgage on the 1414 Property granted by LUCHA on July 20, 1987 and recorded with the Cook County Recorder of Deeds on September 4, 1987; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to an ordinance of the City Council enacted on November 10, 1994, the predecessor department to HED ratified LUCHA's prior transfer of the 1414 Property to 1414 North Washtenaw Limited Partnership, an Illinois limited partnership ("1414 Borrower"), the general partner of which is Borinquen Development Corporation, an Illinois corporation, the owner of which is LUCHA, and

WHEREAS, the predecessor department to HED also ratified 1414 Borrower's assumption of the 1414 Loan's obligations from LUCHA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to three ordinances of the City Council enacted on November 29, 1989, and another ordinance of the City Council enacted on December 20, 1989, the predecessor department to HED made a loan ("Borinquen Apartments Loan") on December 29, 1989 in the original principal amount of \$1,272,491.00 to Borinquen Apartments Limited Partnership, an Illinois limited partnership ("Borinquen Apartments Borrower"), the general partner of which is Guanin Development Corporation, an Illinois corporation, the owner of which is LUCHA, the proceeds of which were used to rehabilitate three apartment buildings located at 1318 N Rockwell (aka 2601 W Evergreen), 1456 N Rockwell and 1451 N Washtenaw, Chicago, Illinois (the "Borinquen Apartments Property"), and

WHEREAS, the Borinquen Apartments Loan was secured by, among other things, a junior Mortgage, Assignment of Rents and Security Agreement on the Borinquen Apartments Property granted by the Borinquen Apartments Borrower on December 29, 1989 and recorded with the Cook County Recorder of Deeds on January 2, 1990; and

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WHEREAS, the Boringuen Apartments Loan was amended by that Amendment to Loan Documents dated June 7, 2001 and recorded with the Cook County Recorder of Deeds on June 8, 2001; and

WHEREAS, the condition of the 1414 Property and the Borinquen Apartments Property (collectively, the "Property") has deteriorated over the years, and

WHEREAS, the Borrower (as defined below) now desires to purchase the Property from the 1414 Borrower and the Borinquen Apartments Borrower for the purpose of rehabilitating the Property as affordable housing, and paying off the 1414 Loan and the Borinquen Apartments Loan with funds from sources other than the Loan or the Grant (as such terms are defined below); and

WHEREAS, the City has certain funds available from a variety of funding sources ("Multi-Family Program Funds") to make loans and grants for the development of multifamily residential housing to increase the number of families served with decent, safe, sanitary and affordable housing and to expand the long-term supply of affordable housing, and such Multi-Family Program Funds are administered by HED; and

WHEREAS, HED has preliminarily reviewed and approved the making of a loan in an amount not to exceed \$3,900,000 (the "Loan"), to be funded from Multi-Family Program Funds pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth in <u>Exhibit A</u> attached hereto and made a part hereof, to Borinquen Bella Limited Partnership, an Illinois limited partnership (the "Borrower"), of which Borinquen Bella Development Corporation, an Illinois corporation (the "Development Corporation"), is the sole general partner, and which, in turn, is controlled by LUCHA (the "Owner") (the Development Corporation and the Owner, the "Affiliates"), or to one of the Affiliates, for the purpose of rehabilitating the Property as affordable housing,

WHEREAS, pursuant to an ordinance published April 22, 2009, at pages 58285-58295 of the Journal of Proceedings of the City Council, the Commissioner of HED (the "Commissioner") and a designee of the Commissioner (collectively, the "Authorized Officer") are authorized to disburse Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant funds ("Energy Efficiency Funds") in the form of subgrants and/or loans; and

WHEREAS, in addition to the Loan, HED has preliminarily reviewed and approved the making of a subgrant in an amount not to exceed \$117,500 (the "Grant"), to be funded from Energy Efficiency Funds pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth in <u>Exhibit A</u> attached hereto and made a part hereof, to the Borrower or to one of the Affiliates, for the purpose of rehabilitating the Property as affordable housing, and

WHEREAS, the making of the Grant is not a condition to the making of the Loan; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. The above recitals are expressly incorporated in and made a part of this ordinance as though fully set forth herein

SECTION 2. Upon the approval and availability of the Additional Financing as shown in Exhibit A hereto, the Authorized Officer is hereby authorized, subject to

approval by the Corporation Counsel, to enter into and execute such agreements, including a regulatory agreement, and instruments, and perform any and all acts, as shall be necessary or advisable in connection with the implementation of the Loan. The Authorized Officer is hereby authorized, subject to the approval of the Corporation Counsel, to negotiate any and all terms and provisions in connection with the Loan which do not substantially modify the terms described in <u>Exhibit A</u> hereto. Upon the execution and receipt of proper documentation, the Authorized Officer is hereby authorized of the Loan to the Borrower or to one of the Affiliates in connection with the Project.

SECTION 3. The Authorized Officer is hereby authorized, subject to approval by the Corporation Counsel, to enter into and execute such agreements and instruments, and perform any and all acts, as shall be necessary or advisable in connection with the implementation of the Grant. The Authorized Officer is hereby authorized, subject to the approval of the Corporation Counsel, to negotiate any and all terms and provisions in connection with the Grant which do not substantially modify the terms described in <u>Exhibit A</u> hereto Upon the execution and receipt of proper documentation, the Authorized Officer is hereby authorized to disburse the proceeds of the Grant to the Borrower or to one of the Affiliates in connection with the Project

SECTION 4. In connection with the Loan by the City to the Borrower or to one of the Affiliates, the City shall waive those certain fees, if applicable, imposed by the City with respect to the Project and as more fully described in <u>Exhibit B</u> attached hereto and made a part hereof. The Project shall be deemed to qualify as "Affordable Housing" for purposes of Chapter 16-18 of the Municipal Code of Chicago Section 2-45-110 of the Municipal Code of Chicago shall not apply to the Project or the Property.

SECTION 5. To the extent that any ordinance, resolution, rule, order or provision of the Municipal Code, or part thereof, is in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, the provisions of this ordinance shall control. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the other provisions of this ordinance.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall be effective as of the date of its passage and approval.






