ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by changing all of the M1-1 Light Manufacturing/Business Park District symbols and indications as shown on Map No. 20-H in the area bounded by

A line 660 feet North of and parallel to the centerline of West 82nd Place; North Hoyne Avenue; A line 550 feet North of and parallel to the centerline of West 82nd Place; A line 357.43 feet West of and parallel to North Hoyne Avenue; an arc with a length of 343.66 feet and a radius of 359.26 feet starting at a point 357.43 feet West of North Hoyne Avenue and 495.09 feet North of the centerline of West 82nd Place and ending at a point 643.82 feet West of North Hoyne Avenue and 660 feet North of the centerline of West 82nd Place,

to those of a M2-1 Light Industry District.

SECTION 2. This ordinance takes effect after its passage and approval.
