# Budget

#### ORDINANCE

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

**SECTION 1.** Section 4-236-020 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by adding the language underscored and by deleting the language struck through, as follows:

## 4-236-020 Tax imposed.

(a) Except as otherwise provided by this Section 4-236-020, there is imposed upon the use and privilege of parking a motor vehicle in or upon any parking lot or garage in the City of Chicago a tax of \$5.00 for each such motor vehicle parked in or upon each parking lot or garage for every 24-hour period or fraction thereof; provided, however, that if the charge for parking is made on a weekly or monthly basis, the tax shall be calculated at the rate of \$25.00 per week or \$120.00 per month, respectively.

### (Omitted text is unaffected by this ordinance)

- (d) (i) The tax imposed by this chapter shall not apply if the charge or fee imposed for the privilege of parking does not exceed \$2.00 for a 24-hour period or less, or \$10.00 for a weekly period or \$40.00 for a monthly period.
- (ii) The tax imposed by this chapter for the privilege of parking for a 24-hour period or less shall be:
  - (1) \$1.00, if the charge or fee is greater than \$2.00 but less than \$5.00;
  - (2) \$1.75, if the charge or fee is \$5.00 or more but less than \$12.00;
  - (3) \$3.00, if the charge or fee is \$12.00 or more and subsection (d)(ii)(4) does not apply paid on a Saturday or Sunday; and
  - (4) \$5.00, if the charge or fee is \$12.00 or more and the person enters the parking garage or parking lot between the hours of 6 a.m. and 6 p.m. paid on a Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday or Friday.

(Omitted text is unaffected by this ordinance)

**SECTION 2.** This ordinance shall take effect after its passage and approval.
