Title:	Amendment of Section 9-64-170 of Municipal Code to allow parking of taxicabs on trial basis on certain business streets within 40th Ward
Committee(s) Assignment:	Committee on Pedestrian and Traffic Safety

Amend 9-64-170 (b) of the municipal code as it pertains to six month trial period to allow taxicab parking on specified streets in the 40th ward.

SECTION 1. Amend the ordinance passed on July 6, 2011, printed on page 3045, which established a six month trial period for Taxicab Parking on Specified Streets in the 40th Ward by striking the struck through language and inserting the underscored language to extend this trial period for an additional six months.

(Omitted text is unaffected by this ordinance)

9-64-170 Parking Restrictions – Special Types Of Vehicles.

(b) It shall be unlawful to park any truck, self- contained motor home, or bus on any business street in the city for a longer period than is necessary for the reasonably expeditious loading or unloading of such vehicle, except that a driver of a bus may park the bus in a designated bus stand as authorized elsewhere in the traffic code. It shall be unlawful to park any taxicab on any business street in the city for a period longer than two hours between the hours of 2:00 A.M. and 7:00 A.M.; provided that this prohibition shall not apply to taxicabs parked on business streets in the 23rd Ward, 40th Ward for a six month trial period starting on the effective date of this amendatory ordinance of 2011 2012, and only on the (north side) of North Lincoln Avenue, from North California Avenue to West Peterson Avenue, (south side) of North Lincoln Avenue, from North California Avenue to West Foster Avenue, (both sides) of North Western Avenue, from West Glenlake Avenue to West Peterson Avenue, (east side) of North Western Avenue, from West Balmoral Avenue to West Peterson Avenue and (south side) of West Peterson Avenue, from North Lincoln Avenue to North California Avenue, 46th ward, 49th Ward and in the 50th Ward (on Devon Avenue and Western Avenue). A violator of this subsection shall be subject to the fine set forth in Section 9-100-020.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication.
