Francis W. Parker School

Be it ordained by the City Council of Chicago:


SECTION 1: That the Commissioner of Buildings, the Commissioner of Environment, the Commissioner of Transportation, The Commissioner of Streets and Sanitation, the Commissioner of Water Management, the Commissioner of Fire, the Executive Director of Construction and Permits, and the Director of Business Affairs and Licensing, are hereby directed to issue all necessary permits, all on-site water/sewer inspection fees and all water/sewer plan fees, free of charge, notwithstanding other ordinances of the City of Chicago to the contrary, to Francis W. Parker School, a not for profit educational institution, located at 330 West Webster Avenue and 2234 North Clark Street, related to the renovation, erection, and maintenance of various building(s) within the 43rd Ward.

Said building and all appurtenances thereto shall be used exclusively for educational purposes and shall not be leased or otherwise used with a view to profit, and the work thereon shall be done in accordance with plans submitted and all of the appropriate provisions of the Municipal Code of the City of Chicago and departmental requirements of various departments of the City of Chicago, and said building and all appurtenances thereto shall be constructed and maintained so that they shall comply in all respects with the requirements of the appropriate provision of the Municipal Code of the City of Chicago for the issuance of all permits and licenses.

SECTION 2: The Francis W. Parker School, a not for profit educational institution, engaged in educational and related activities, shall be exempt from the payment of city license fees and shall be entitled to the cancellation of warrants for the collection of inspection fees.

SECTION 3: The Francis W. Parker School shall be entitled to a refund of city fees which it has paid and from which it is exempt pursuant to Sections 1 and 2 of this ordinance.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall be in force for a period of (2) years, but in no event beyond December 31, 2013.
