ORDINANCE

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago


SECTION 1. That the Commissioner of Buildings, the Commissioner of Environment, the Commissioner of Transportation, the Commissioner of Streets and Sanitation, the Commissioner of Water Management, the Commissioner of Fire, the Executive Director of Construction and Permits and the Director of the Department of Business Affairs and Licensing are hereby directed to issue all necessary permits, all on-site water/sewer inspection fees and all water/sewer plan review fees, free of charge, notwithstanding other ordinances of the City of Chicago to the contrary, to Easter Seals Metropolitan Chicago, a not-for-profit Illinois corporation, located at 1939 West 13th Street related to the renovation, erection and maintenance of various building(s) within the 2nd Ward.

Said building(s) and appurtenances thereto shall be used exclusively for charitable purposes and shall not be leased or otherwise used with a view to profit, and the work thereon shall be done in accordance with plans submitted and all appropriate provisions of the Municipal Code of the City of Chicago and departmental requirements of various departments of the City of Chicago, and said building(s) and all appurtenances thereto shall be constructed and maintained so that they shall comply in all respects with the requirements of the appropriate provisions of the Municipal Code of the City of Chicago for the issuance of all permits and licenses.

SECTION 2. Easter Seals Metropolitan Chicago, a not-for-profit Illinois corporation engaged in providing comprehensive services for individuals with disabilities or other special needs and their families to improve quality of life and maximize independence, shall be exempt from the payment of city license fees and shall be entitled to the cancellation of warrants for the collection of inspection fees.

SECTION 3. Easter Seals Metropolitan Chicago shall be entitled to a refund of city fees which it has paid and from which it is exempt pursuant to Sections 1 and 2 of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be in force for a period of two (2) years but in no event beyond December 31, 2014.
