The applicant seeks to expand a licensed Laundromat to include coin operated laundry that has been on this site for thirty (30) years but which had previously been categorized as a drop off laundry. The change to B3 will allow the issuance of a City Business License for a coin operated laundry at this address. The applicant has agreed to rezone the property back to a B1 after the license is issued to insure that the use of the property remains the same.


