ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by changing all of the RT4 Residential Two-Flat, Townhouse and Multi-Unit District symbols and indications as shown on Map No. 6-I in the area bounded by

A line 124.10 feet long perpendicular to West 23rd Place and 97 feet west of and parallel to South Rockwell Street; the public alley next south of and parallel to West 23rd Place and perpendicular to South Rockwell Street; a line 124.10 feet long perpendicular to West 23rd Place and 121 feet west of and parallel to South Rockwell Street; West 23rd Place,

to those of an RM4.5 Residential Multi-Unit District.

SECTION 2. This ordinance takes effect after its passage and approval.

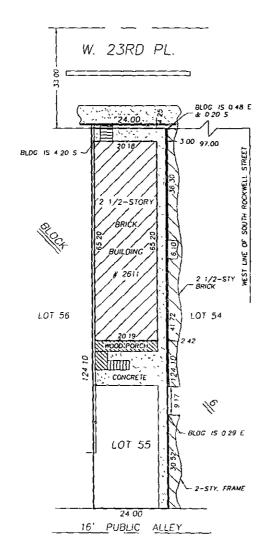

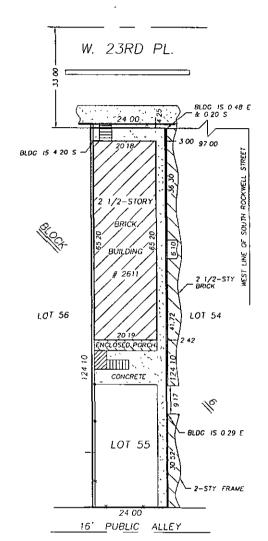
