WHEREAS, A native of Chicago, the Honorable Susan Tutt-Parsons graduated from Kelly High School and Northern Illinois University where she earned a bachelor's degree in English and a master's degree in communications; and

WHEREAS, The Honorable Susan Tutt-Parsons married Ronald Tutt and the couple moved to La Grange Park in the late 1970s; and

WHEREAS, The Honorable Susan Tutt-Parsons was the mother of two children, Jillian and Josuha, when he husband passed away; and

WHEREAS, During the 1990s, the Honorable Susan Tutt-Parsons coowned the Harris Market, a gift shop and art gallery in the western suburb; and

WHEREAS, The Honorable Susan Tutt-Parsons was a Past President of the West Suburban Chamber of Commerce who named her Woman of the Year in 1993 and honored her with its President's Award in 2005; and

WHEREAS, The Honorable Susan Tutt-Parsons married Alec Parsons and became the step-mother of Adam Parsons; and

WHEREAS, The hard work, sacrifice and dedication of the Honorable Susan Tutt-Parsons serve as an example to all; and

WHEREAS, To her beloved family, the Honorable Susan Tutt-Parsons imparts a legacy of faithfulness, service and dignity; now, therefore
