**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF CHICAGO**

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Section 9-64-090 (f) of the Code, the following address ranges are designated as buffer zones for a residential parking zone (Zone 62). The residents living in the following address ranges of the indicated streets are eligible to acquire a permit to park in the adjacent residential parking permit zone (Zone 62), as a result of insufficient available parking caused by that adjacent zone:

1609 to 1962 W. Lawrence (Both sides of the street)  
1618 to 1774 W. Ainslie (Both sides of the street)  
1650 to 1800 W. Ainslie (South Side of the street)  
1900 to 1950 W. Ainslie (Both sides of the street)  
1806 to 1927 W. Argyle (South side of the street)  
4600 to 4747 N. Damen (Both sides of the street)  
1600 to 2035 W. Wilson (North side of the street)  
1620 to 1700 W Leland (both sides of the street)

SECTION 2. This ordinance will be in full force and effect upon passage and publication.
