I am writing to notify you that on behalf of my client, Terrence Lyons, I will file on or about April 10, 2012, an application for a change of zoning designation from a B1-1 Neighborhood Shopping District to a C1-2 Neighborhood Commercial District under the Ordinance of the City of Chicago for the property located at 1619-25 West Irving Park Road, Illinois, and further described as follows:

WEST IRVING PARK ROAD; A LINE 85.12 FEET EAST OF AND PARALLEL TO NORTH MARSHFIELD AVENUE; THE ALLEY NEXT SOUTH OF WEST IRVING PARK ROAD, AND, NORTH MARSHFIELD AVENUE.

City Ordinance (Municipal Code, Section 17-13-0107) requires that I send you this notice.

The zoning amendment is sought in order to demolish the easternmost portion of the existing building which is currently improved with a two story, brick, mixed use building. As you are aware the demolition is necessitated by a recent fire. Mr. Lyons will improve the easternmost portion of the site with a three story brick building. The first two stories of the new building will be used as space for the existing, adjoined restaurant. The third story will contain four residential units.

Please note that the applicant is not seeking to purchase or amend the zoning of your property. The applicant is required by law to send this notice because you own property within 250 feet of the subject site.

Legal title to the property is held by Terrence Lyons of 1625 West Irving Park Road, Chicago, Illinois.




