ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. The City Council finds that the areas described in this ordinance are adversely affected by the over-concentration of businesses licensed to sell alcoholic liquor within and near the areas.

SECTION 2. Section 4-60-022 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by inserting the underscored language as a new subsection 4-60-022 (42.6), as follows:

4-60-022 Restrictions On Additional Licenses.

Subject to the provisions of subsection 4-60-021(c), no additional license shall be issued for the sale of alcoholic liquor, for consumption on the premises within the following areas:

(Omitted text is unaffected by this ordinance)

(42.6) Within the area described as follows: beginning at the intersection of North Franklin Street and West Illinois Street thence easterly on West Illinois Street to North Wabash Avenue; thence south on North Wabash Avenue to the north bank of the Chicago River; thence westerly on the north bank of the Chicago River to North Wells Street; thence north on North Wells Street to West Kinzie Street; thence westerly on West Kinzie Street to North Franklin Street to the intersection of West Illinois Street and North Franklin Street.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
