33 N LASALLE BUILDING/GOLUB & COMPANY

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to 33 N LASALLE BUILDING/GOLUB & COMPANY, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use, as now constructed, one (1) Pedestrian Tunnel or Passage way under West Calhoun Place, twenty-eight (28) feet east of the easterly side of North La Salle Street, at a depth of twenty-one (21!) feet three (3) inches, constructed diagonally, twenty-two (22) feet in length and fourteen (14) feet in width, outside dimensions, a total of five hundred seventy-three (573) square feet, to connect the premises at 1 North LaSalle Street with 33 North LaSalle Street. Existing tunnel shall be twenty-two (22) feet in length and fourteen (14) feet in width for a total of three hundred eight (308) square feet.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Planning and Development and Department of Transportation (Office of Underground Coordination).

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1099561 herein granted the sum of three thousand eight hundred thirty-two (\$3,832.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

Authority herein given and granted for a period of five (5) years from and after 02/09/2012.
