Grant(s) of privilege in public way for 100 East Huron Street Condominium Association Committee on Transportation and Public Way

ORDINANCE 100 EAST HURON STREET CONDOMINIUM ASSOCIATION Acct. No. 68623 - 1 Permit No. 1101515

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to 100 EAST HURON STREET CONDOMINIUM ASSOCIATION, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to construct, install, maintain and use twelve (12) Recessed Light(s) on the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 100 E. Huron St..

Said Recessed Light(s) at E. huron measure(s):

Twelve (12) at one (1) foot in length, and one (1) foot in width for a total of twelve (12) square feet.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Streets and Sanitation (Bureau of Electricity) and Department of Transportation (Division of Project Development).

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1101515 herein granted the sum of one hundred thirty (\$130.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

Authority herein given and granted for a period of five (5) years from and after Date of Passage.
