I am writing to notify you that on behalf of my applicant/owner, Gloria Mallasch, I will file on or about October 22, 2012, an application for a change of zoning designation from a RS-3 Residential Single-Unit (Detached House) District to a RT 3.5 Residential Two-Flat, Townhouse and Multi-Unit District under the Ordinance of the City of Chicago for the property located at 4244-48 North Whipple Street, Chicago, Illinois, and further described as follows:

Please note that the applicant is not seeking to purchase or amend the zoning of your property. The applicant is required by law to send this notice because you own property within 250 feet of the subject site.
