THE UNIVERSITY OF CHICAGO

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to THE UNIVERSITY OF CHICAGO, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use one (1) sign(s) projecting over the public right-of-way attached to its premises known as 1168-72 E. 55th St..

Said sign structure(s) measures as follows; along East 55th Street: One (1) at twenty point one seven (20.17) feet in length, one point five (1.5) feet in height and thirteen point five (13.5) feet above grade level.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Transportation (Division of Project Development) and Zoning Department- Signs.

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1103731 herein granted the sum of three hundred (\$300.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

Authority herein given and granted for a period offive (5) years from and after Date of Passage.

REVERSE CHANNEL LETTER SPECIFICATIONS:

Reverse Channel Letters: Routed .090" aluminum faces, .063" x 2" tall returns internally welded construction, seams sealed, drain holes.

Letter Finish: Letter interiors painted "White" enamel, exteriors vertical grain sanded, clear anodized aluminum.


Letter Backs: Routed 3/16" clear polycarbonite, pin mounted 1" out from building face.

Lighting: Wall lit from LED's in individual letters.


Electrical: 120volt, UL listed & labeled, Sloan "Modular 60" power supplies mounted inside building.

Location. Sign centered between columns left to right and top to bottom on front section of wall (per photo to right).
