ORDINANCE
THE UNIVERSITY OF CHICAGO (FILE #56)
Acct. No. 43697 - 75
Permit No. 1104876

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to THE UNIVERSITY OF CHICAGO (FILE #56), upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to construct, install, maintain and use one (1) Trench(s) under the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 5640 S. Ellis Ave..

Said Trench(s) at S. Ellis Avenue measure(s):

One (1) at seventy-three (73) feet in length, and nine (9) feet in width for a total of six hundred fifty-seven (657) square feet. Within said trench shall be three (3) pipes. Steam pipe, condensate pipe, and high pressure return line pipe to cross underneath South Ellis Avenue at a depth of approximately ten (10) feet.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Planning and Development and Department of Transportation (Office of Underground Coordination).

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.


The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1104876 herein granted the sum of one thousand two hundred (\$1,200.00) annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

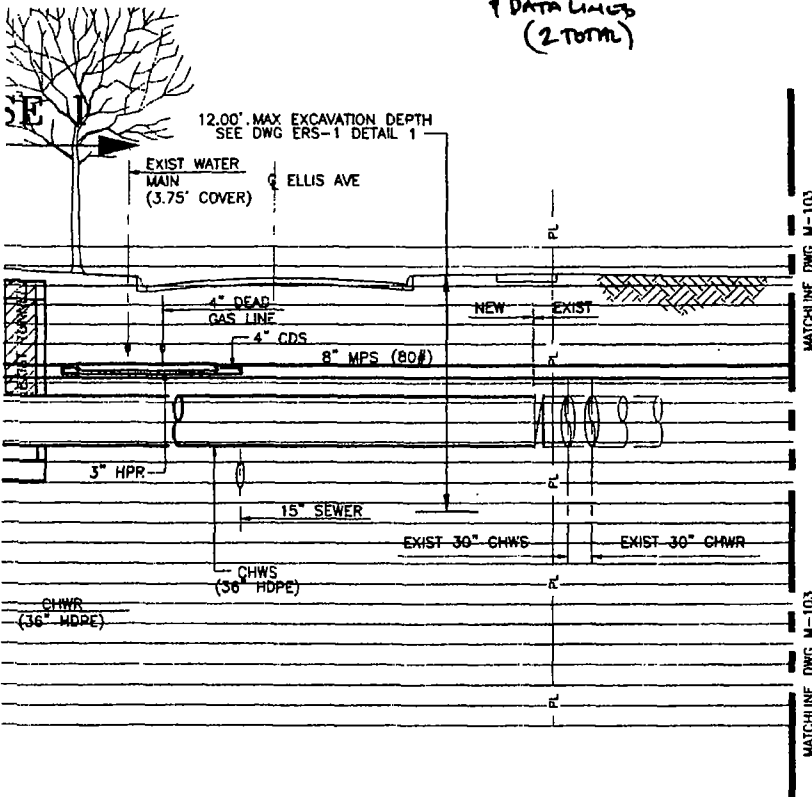
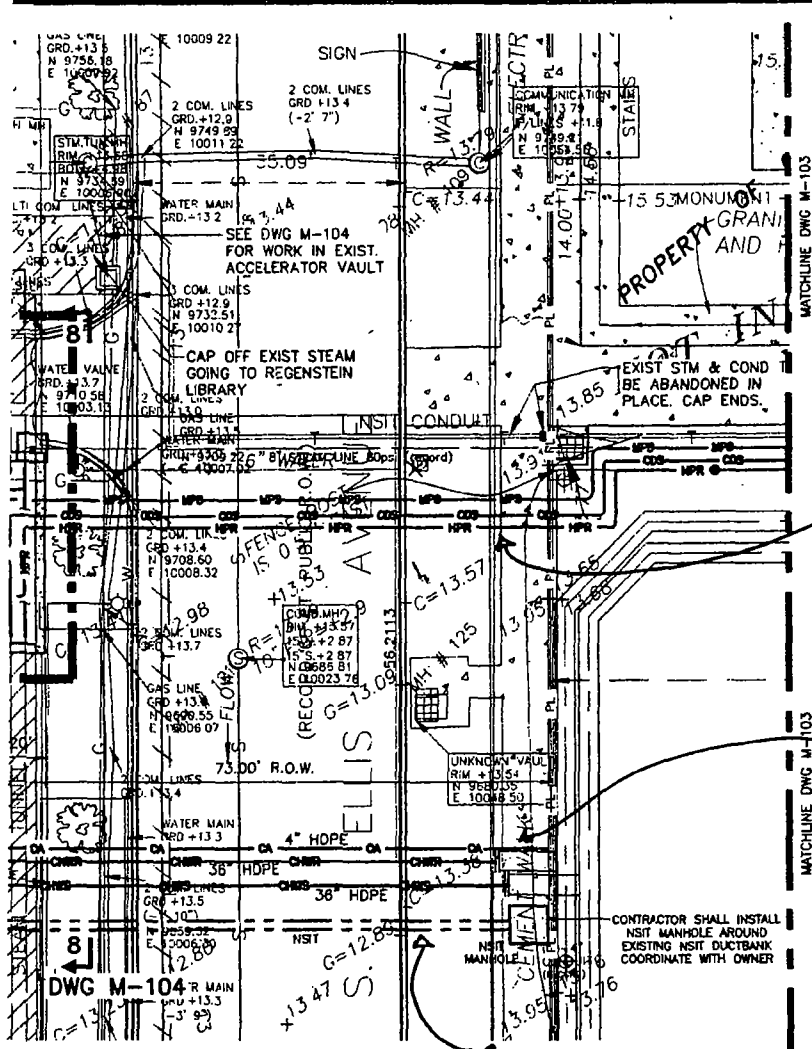
The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.
