## ***RESOLUTION***

***WHEREAS***, Captain Donald Freza has officially retired as a member of the Chicago Fire Department following more than three decades of distinguished service; and

***WHEREAS***, The Chicago City Council has been informed of this event by Alderman Edward M. Burke; and

***WHEREAS***, Captain Donald Freza began his illustrious tenure as a firefighter with the City of Chicago on February 18, 1980; and

***WHEREAS***, Donald Freza's first assignment was a nine-year stint at Truck (later changed to Tower Ladder) 39; and

***WHEREAS***, Donald Freza was promoted to Lieutenant and assigned to District 5 Relief for ten years before finding a home at Engine Company 123; and

***WHEREAS***, In 2006 Donald Freza was promoted to Captain and was assigned to District 1 Relief; and

***WHEREAS***, On February 16, 2007, Donald Freza was assigned to Truck 11, where he ably served for the remainder of his career; and

***WHEREAS***, Donald Freza retired at the end of 2012 after serving the citizens of Chicago for thirty-two years; and

***WHEREAS***, Donald Freza received numerous Unit Citation Awards during his years in service; and

***WHEREAS***, The hard work, sacrifice and dedication of Captain Donald Freza serve as an example to all; now, therefore

***BE IT RESOLVED***, That we, the Mayor and the members of the Chicago City Council, assembled this tenth day of April, 2013, do hereby express our sincere appreciation to Captain Donald Freza for his dedicated service on behalf of the people of the City of Chicago; and
