Grant(s) of privilege in public way for 437 Rush - light fixtures Committee on Transportation and Public Way ORDINANCE 437 RUSH Acct. No. 85155 - 1 Permit No. 1107146

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to 437 RUSH, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use, as now constructed, fifteen (15) Light Fixture(s) projecting over the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 437 N. Rush St..

Said Light Fixture(s) at N. Rush St. measure(s):

Six (6) at point five (.5) feet in length, point six seven (.67) feet in width and thirty-five (35) feet above grade level. Nine (9) at point five (.5) feet in length, point six seven (.67) feet in width and fifty (50) feet above grade level.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Transportation (Division of Project Development).

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1107146 herein granted the sum of one hundred forty-five (\$145.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.


