### ORDINANCE

### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

**SECTION 1.** The City Council finds that the areas described in this ordinance are adversely affected by the over-concentration of businesses licensed to sell alcoholic liquor within and near the areas.

**SECTION 2.** Section 4-60-022 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by inserting the underscored language as a new subsection 4-60-022 (42.5) through 4-60-022 (42.28), as follows:

#### 4-60-022 Restrictions On Additional Licenses.

Subject to the provisions of subsection 4-60-021(c), no additional license shall be issued for the sale of alcoholic liquor, for consumption on the premises within the following areas:

- (42.13) On the east side of Franklin Street, from Ontario Street to Huron Street.
- (42.14) On the west side of Franklin Street, from Ontario Street to Huron Street.

- (42.15) On the north side of Illinois Street, from State Street to Clark Street.
- (42.16) On the north side of Illinois Street, from Clark Street to Wells Street.
- (42.17) On the south side of Illinois Street, from State Street to Clark Street.
- (42.18) On the south side of Illinois Street, from Clark Street to Wells Street.
- (42.19) On the east side of Dearborn Street, from the north bank of the Chicago River to Illinois Street.
- (42,20) On the west side of Dearborn Street, from the north bank of the Chicago River to Illinois Street.
- (42.21) On the east side of Clark Street, from the north bank of the Chicago River to Illinois Street.
- (42.22) On the west side of Clark Street, from the north bank of the Chicago River to Illinois Street.
- (42.23) On the east side of LaSalle Street, from the north bank of the Chicago River to Illinois Street.
- (42,24) On the west side of LaSalle Street, from the north bank of the Chicago River to Illinois Street.
- (42.25) On the east side of Wells Street, from the north bank of the Chicago River to Illinois Street.
