#### <u>ORDINANCE</u>

#### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by changing all the M1-2 Limited Manufacturing / Business Park

District symbols and indications as shown on Map No.11-H in the area bounded by

beginning at a point 117.92 feet west of North Ravenswood Avenue and 277.25 feet north of West Leland Avenue; a line from a point 117.92 feet west of North Ravenswood Avenue and 277.25 feet north of West Leland Avenue; to a point, 260.13 feet north of West Leland Avenue and the west right-of-way line of North Ravenswood Avenue; North Ravenswood Avenue; West Leland Avenue; the alley next west of and parallel to North Ravenswood Avenue; and a line from a point 262.63 feet north of West Leland Avenue and the east right-of-way line of the alley next west of and parallel to North Ravenswood Avenue; back to the point of beginning (which is at 117.92 feet west of North Ravenswood Avenue and 277.25 feet north of West Leland Avenue),

to those of a C1-2 Neighborhood Commercial District and a corresponding uses district is hereby established in the area above described.

**SECTION 2.** This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and due publication.








Existing West Elevation
