AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE NEGOTIATED SALE OF THE VACANT FIRE HOUSE AT 3500 W. 60TH STREET

WHEREAS, the City of Chicago ("City") is a home rule unit of government by virtue of the provisions of the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970, and as such, may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, the City is the owner of the approximately 6,673 square foot parcel of real property improved with a vacant fire house located at 3500 West 60th Street, Chicago, Illinois, and which is legally described on Exhibit A attached hereto (the "Property"); and

WHEREAS, public notice advertising the City's intent to sell the Property appeared in the *Chicago Sun-Times*, a newspaper of general circulation, on June 5, 12 and 19, 2012 at a listing price of \$180,000, being the market value as determined by appraisal; and

WHEREAS, no bids were received; and

WHEREAS, public notice advertising the City's intent to sell the Property again appeared in the *Chicago Sun-Times*, on April 25, 2013, and May 2 and 9, 2013; and

WHEREAS, two bids were received for the Property; and

WHEREAS, the higher of the two bids was submitted by Jean Paul and Laura Burgos (collectively, the "Grantee"), 3449 W. 59th Street, Chicago, IL 60629, in the amount of Eighty-One Thousand Five Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$81,500.00); and

WHEREAS, the Grantee intends to convert the vacant fire house to a single family residence for the Grantee's personal use; and

WHEREAS, the Property was marketed by the City's real estate broker, Jones Lang LaSalle, pursuant to the terms of their master consulting agreement, with the transaction subject to subject to a five percent (5%) brokerage commission credited against an Eight Thousand Three Hundred Fifty and No/Dollars (\$8,350) upfront brokerage fee; and

WHEREAS, Jones Lang LaSalle's upfront brokerage fee exceeds the five percent brokerage commission with respect to the Property and no further amount is owed; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No.13-052-21 adopted on August 15, 2013, the Chicago Plan Commission recommended that the City through its Department of Housing and Economic Development ("DHED") enter into a negotiated sale with the Grantee for the purchase of the Property; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City hereby approves the sale of the Property to the Grantee for the amount of Eighty-One Thousand Five Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$81,500.00).

SECTION 2. The Commissioner or the Deputy Commissioner of DHED are each authorized to execute any ancillary closing documents on behalf of the City.

SECTION 3. The Mayor or his proxy is authorized to execute, and the City Clerk or the Deputy City Clerk is authorized to attest, a quitclaim deed conveying the Property to the Grantee. The quitclaim deed shall contain language substantially in the following form:

- (1) The City makes no covenant, representation or warranty, express or implied, of any kind, as to the structural, physical or environmental condition of the Property or the suitability of the Property for any purpose whatsoever, and the Grantee agrees to accept the Property in its "as is," "where is" and "with all faults" condition.
- (2) The Grantee hereby waives and releases, and indemnifies the City from and against, any claims and liabilities relating to or arising from the structural, physical or environmental condition of the Property, including, without limitation, claims arising under the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act of 1980, as amended ("CERCLA"), and shall undertake and discharge all liabilities of the City arising from any structural, physical or environmental condition that existed on the Property prior to the Closing, including, without limitation, liabilities arising under CERCLA. The Grantee hereby acknowledges that, in purchasing the Property, the Grantee is relying solely upon its own inspection and other due diligence activities and not upon any information (including, without limitation, environmental studies or reports of any kind) provided by or on behalf of the City or its agents or employees with respect thereto. If, after the Closing, the structural, physical and environmental condition of the Property is not in all respects entirely suitable for its intended use, it shall be the Grantee's sole responsibility and obligation to take such action as is necessary to put the Property in a condition which is suitable for its intended use.

SECTION 4. The transfer of title of the Property to the Grantee must close on or before 90 days from the publication of this ordinance (the "Outside Closing Date"). If the closing does not occur by the Outside Closing Date, this ordinance shall be null and void and the Grantee shall forfeit the Six Thousand and No/Dollars (\$6,000) good faith purchase deposit tendered concurrently with Grantee's bid.

SECTION 5. If any provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such provision shall not affect any of the other provisions of this ordinance.

SECTION 6. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 7. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval.

If the City determines that any information provided in this EDS is false, incomplete or inaccurate, any contract or other agreement in connection with which it is submitted may be rescinded or be void or voidable, and the City may pursue any remedies under the contract or agreement (if not rescinded or void), at law, or in equity, including terminating the Disclosing Party's participation in the Matter and/or declining to allow the Disclosing Party to participate in other transactions with the City. Remedies at law for a false statement of material fact may include incarceration and an award to the City of treble damages.
- D. It is the City's policy to make this document available to the public on its Internet site and/or upon request. Some or all of the information provided on this EDS and any attachments to this EDS may be made available to the public on the Internet, in response to a Freedom of Information Act request, or otherwise. By completing and signing this EDS, the Disclosing Party waives and releases any possible rights or claims which it may have against the City in connection with the public release of information contained in this EDS and also authorizes the City to verify the accuracy of any information submitted in this EDS.
- E. The information provided in this EDS must be kept current. In the event of changes, the Disclosing Party must supplement this EDS up to the time the City takes action on the Matter. This includes, but is not limited to, all water charges, sewer charges, license fees, parking tickets, property taxes or sales taxes.
- F.2 If the Disclosing Party is the Applicant, the Disclosing Party and its Affiliated Entities will not use, nor permit their subcontractors to use, any facility listed by the U.S. E.P.A. on the federal Excluded Parties List System ("EPLS") maintained by the U.S. General Services Administration.
- F.3 If the Disclosing Party is the Applicant, the Disclosing Party will obtain from any contractors/subcontractors hired or to be hired in connection with the Matter certifications equal in form and substance to those in F.1. and F.2. above and will not, without the prior written consent of the City, use any such contractor/subcontractor that does not provide such certifications or that the Disclosing Party has reason to believe has not provided or cannot provide truthful certifications.
