2100 S Indiana Avenue Equities, LLC

*Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:*

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to 2100 S Indiana Avenue Equities, LLC, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to construct, install, maintain and use one (1) Awning(s) projecting over the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 125 E. 21st St..

Said Awning(s) at East 21st Street measure(s):

One (1) at twelve point one seven (12.17) feet in length, and three (3) feet in width for a total of thirty-six point five one (36.51) square feet.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Zoning Department - Signs.

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1107718 herein granted the sum of fifty (\$50.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

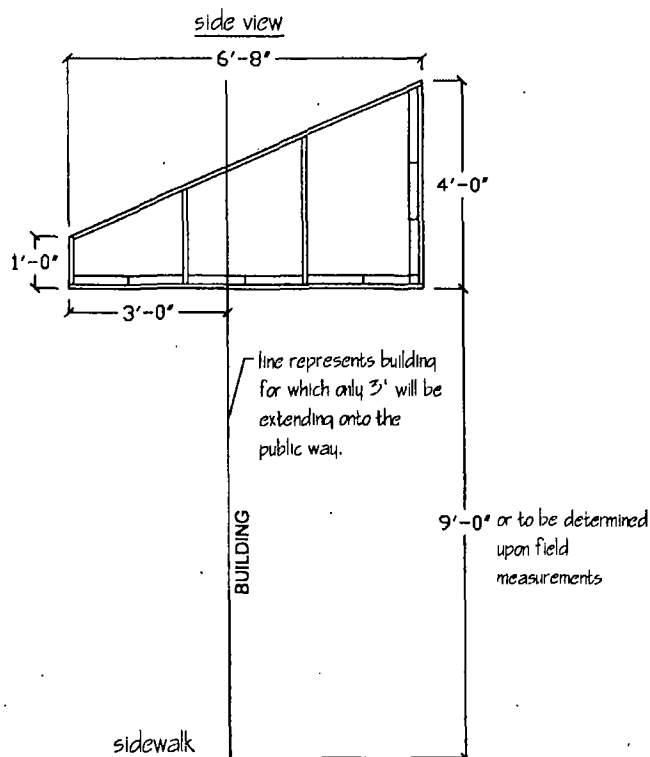
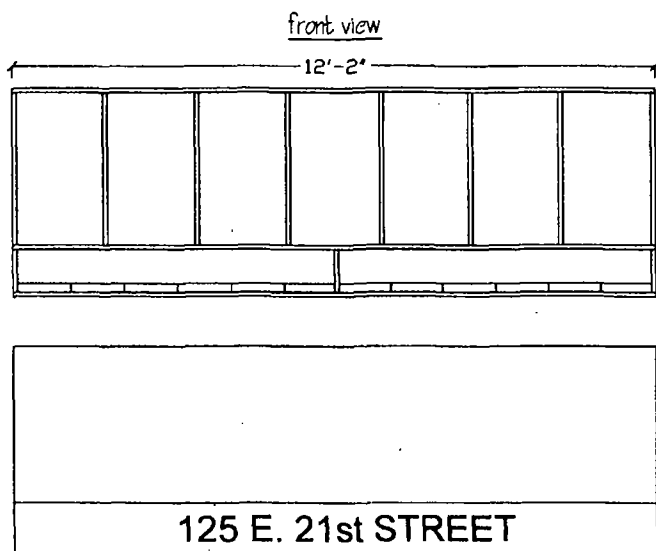

Traditional style stationary awning, with end wings and a stationary valance manufactured complete and installed over the N/F entrance. Frames made of 1" sq. welded galvanized steel tubing, with welds ground, primed and painted BLACK. Awnings mounted to wall with  $\frac{3}{8}$ " x 3" lag bolts and  $\frac{5}{8}$ " x 2" lag shields. Fabric attached by the lace-on method, using Sunbrella material # 4608, Black.
