#### WARD MISCELLEANEOUS:

47 4002 N. Leavitt Street: Repeal ordinance passed 5/9/91, journal page 79 which reads: 4002 N. Leavitt Street (west side) from a point 30 feet north of W. Irving Park Road to a point 95 feet north thereof; One Hour Parking, 11:00am to 8:00pm, Monday through Saturday, by striking the above -- (13-01586237) [O2013-697]
