#### **LOADING ZONES**

### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 64, Section 160, of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the following locations are hereby designated as Loading Zones for the distances specified, during the hours specified:

2	S. Michigan Avenue (east side) from a point 200 feet south of E. 18th Street to a point 40 feet south thereof; 30 Minute Standing Zone, use flashing lights, 9:00am to 6:00pm, Monday through Saturday (13-00799596) [O2013-1654]
