Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of the City of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by changing the designation and appropriate symbols and indications of a segment of the North Lincoln Avenue right-of-way on Map Number 11-H in the area bounded by:

the south line of West Pensacola Avenue to a line 362 feet north of the south line of West Montrose Avenue,

to remove all designations of such segment as a Pedestrian Retail Street.

SECTION 2. Section 17-3-0503-D of Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by deleting the stricken language and inserting the underscored language, as follows:

[The other pedestrian streets and pedestrian retail streets in these subsections are unaffected by the changes and are not included for editorial convenience.]

17-3-0503-D [Pedestrian Streets and Pedestrian Retail Streets.]

1. The following street segments are classified as pedestrian streets:

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in force and effect upon passage and publication.
