BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Section 3-56-050 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by deleting the language stricken through and by inserting the language underscored, as follows:

3-56-050 Fees – Late fees.

<i>Vehicle</i>	<i>Fee</i>
Smaller <u>passenger automobiles</u> , or larger passenger automobiles <u>or motorcycles</u> only, not more than one <u>motor</u> vehicle, registered to a person 65 years of age or older, upon satisfactory proof of age and <u>motor</u> vehicle ownership	\$30.00

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take full force and effect upon its passage and publication.
