<u>SUBSTITUTE ORDINANCE</u>

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Section 4-60-022 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by deleting the language struck through as follows:

4-60-022 Restriction on additional licenses.

Subject to the provisions of subsection 4-60-021(c), no additional license shall be issued for the sale of alcoholic liquor, for consumption on the premises located within the following areas:

(25.136) On Ashland Avenue, from Cermak Road to the South-Branch of the Chicago River.
