<u>ORDINANCE</u>

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by changing all the RT4 Residential two-flat, Townhouse and Multi-unit District symbols and indications as shown on Map No.3-F in the area bounded by

West Locust Street; a line 183.80 feet east of and parallel to North Sedgwick Street; a line 109.25 feet south of and parallel to West Locust Street; a line 129.31 feet east of and parallel to North Sedgwick Street; a line 100.26 feet south of and parallel to West Locust Street; and North Sedgwick Street,

to those of a C2-5 Motor Vehicle-Related Commercial District and a corresponding uses district is hereby established in the area above described.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and due publication.

Without our permission, someone formed and listed the Archdiocese as a not for profit corporation with the Illinois Secretary of State. Also on that website, The Catholic Bishop of Chicago appears accurately as a Special Act Corporation (file number 55013179).




First Floor Plan



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
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
