23	W. 53rd Street; W. 53rd Street (south side) from S. Cicero Avenue to S. Keating Avenue; Two Hour Parking, 6:00am to 6:00pm, Monday through Friday [O2014-5891]

**SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force here in after its passage and publication.**


