ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by changing all of the B3-3 Community Shopping District (Type 1) symbols and indications as shown on Map No. 5-H in the area bounded by

a line 72 feet north of and parallel to West Wabansia Avenue; North Damen Avenue; a line 48 feet north of and parallel to West Wabansia Avenue; and the alley next west of and parallel to North Damen Avenue,

to those of a B3-2 Community Shopping District and a corresponding use district is hereby established in the area above described.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

Dear Property Owner:

In accordance with the requirements for an Amendment to the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, specifically Section 17-13-0107, please be informed that on or about December 3, 2014, the undersigned intends to file an application for a change in zoning for the property commonly known as 1704 North Damen Avenue (the "Property") from B3-3 Community Shopping District (Type 1) to B3-2 Community Shopping District.

You may have received a similar notice in early September. At that time, the applicant had sought to change the zoning to correct certain inconsistencies between the actual building plans and the applicant's May 2014 rezoning application. In order to address certain community members' concerns about the zoning precedent set by a B3-3 classification, the applicant agreed to down zone the property to B3-2 Community Shopping District upon approval of the rezoning to the B3-3 classification and issuance of a full building permit.

The Property is currently under construction for a three-story, retail building. The applicant has obtained a building permit that will permit the construction of a three-story, approximately 5,280 square foot retail building with no parking spaces. The building will be no taller than 39'10" in height. The bulk and density of this building will be consistent with the limitations of a property zoned B3-2.






